



**\*Dwight Murray (Opal “Billie”) District Governor 1947-1948 (District 13D)**

Dwight was the son of Anna Breyman and Medlow Murray (a quadruplet) and a twin to Dwain Murray. On 8 Sep 1925 in Bluffton, Allen, Ohio, he married Opal L. Crates. They had one daughter, Patricia.

Dwight was one of the last persons in Ohio to become an attorney without attending law school. Instead, he studied law at night under the tutelage of Findlay attorneys, passing the Ohio bar exam in 1938. He later became a Municipal Judge for Findlay, Ohio.

He was a member of the Odd Fellows; Rebekah and Moose Lodges; Findlay & National Associations of Retired Persons; Member & Past President of Findlay Lions Club and District Governor for the Lions in 1948; City-County Northwest Ohio and State Bar Associations.
