The president of the Union Banking Co. in West Mansfield died 5:30 a.m. today at Hardin Memorial Hospital, where he was admitted early in the morning.

He was born May 16, 1900, in Napoleon to Charles and Alice (Slentz) Shoemaker. He had lived in Dunkirk 47 years.

He was a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Dunkirk; the West Mansfield Lions Club, past district governor of Lions International; a member of the Dunkirk Masonic Lodge.

He was appointed to the Hardin county school board on Oct. 3, 1963 to serve the unexpired term of M. E. Blue. He was elected to the board and served until he retired from the board in January 1970.

He was married in 1919 to Nellie Jennings. She survives along with a daughter, Grace Shoemaker of Dunkirk; a son, Robert of Bowling Green; two grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Leonard (Jennie) Griteman of Napoleon.
