

## **Wilbur E. (Bill) Hughes**

**HUNTSVILLE —** Wilbur E. (Bill) Hughes, 79, died at 1:35 p.m. Wednesday at Heartland of Indian Lake in Lakeview.

He was born July 30, 1913, in MacArthur Township, Logan County, the son of Ornell Scott and Bertha Jane Harrison Hughes. On Aug. 21, 1931, he married Mary Elizabeth (Betty) Griffith, who survives.

Mr. Hughes was a farmer. He was a member of First United Presbyterian Church in Bellefontaine, Past District Governor of Lions International in 1978 and 1979 and a 1931 graduate of Huntsville High School. He was a charter member of McArthur-Huntsville Grange, where he maintained a perfect attendance and received the Melvin Jones Award. He was a member of the Logan County Board of Education for 25 years and one of the first board members of Ohio Hi Point Joint Vocational School, where he served for 14 years.

He was named outstanding farmer in 1967, was a former 4-H leader and a member of the Logan County Farm Bureau.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Robert (Patricia Ann) Folland of Fredericktown; one son, William R. Hughes of Houston, Texas; six grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by five sisters and six brothers.

Services will be at 10 a.m. Saturday at the Van Horn Funeral Home, Lakeview, Rev. Rob Fulton officiating. Burial will be in Huntsville Cemetery, Huntsville.
