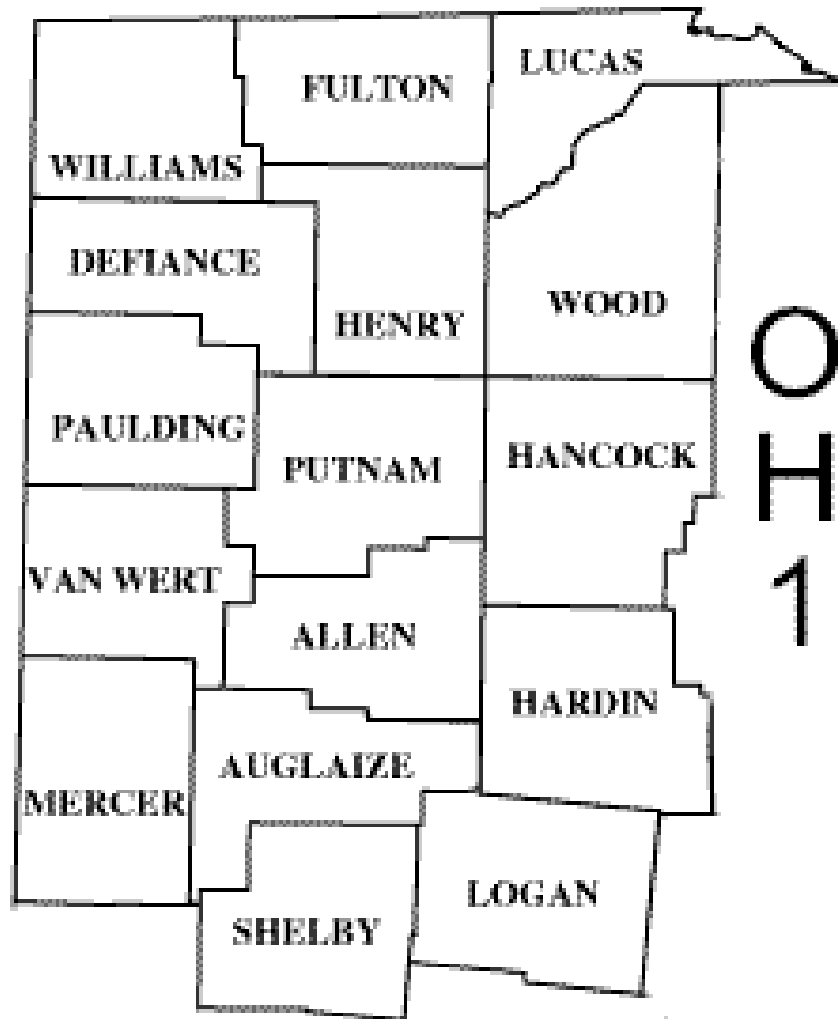


District Governors of OH1 1970-1979

*** Thomas W. Miles (Pauline) District Governor 1970-1971 District 13A**

Governor Miles was born October 28, 1907, at Truro, Nova Scotia, Canada.

He is a citizen of the United States, and came, as a small child, with his parents to Findlay, Ohio, and received his education in the Findlay school system.

***Robert C. Oberhouse (Lu) District Governor 1975-1976 District 13A**

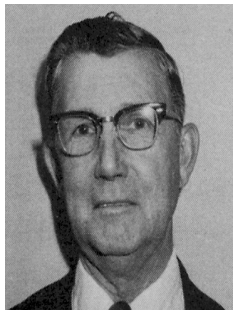

The Governor's hobbies include fishing, gardening, reading and traveling.



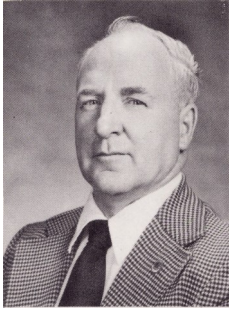
***Dale D Harruff (Katherine) District Governor 1976-1977 District 13A**

Governor Hughes was born July 30, 1913 in Logan County near Huntsville, Ohio. He is a graduate of Huntsville High School.

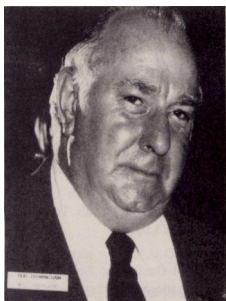
