

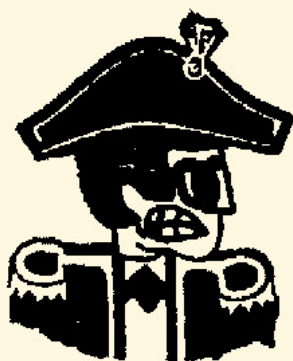
Four Teens Join Cancer Program
